About the city

Catalonia has become one of the first <u>tourist destination</u> of Spain, it has everything to please the majority of visitors: with a history among the oldest in Europe, a capital, Barcelona, which never sleeps and an inland full of charm not to forget beautiful beaches in La Costa Brava. The variety of artistic treasures, the Romanesque churches and the great names in modern art and architecture, <u>Dali, Gaudi, Miro, Picasso</u>. You can visit their museums and/or representative art such as Houses, Cathedrals, in Barcelona, "The city of Marvels".

Barcelona, located between the sea and the mountains, has found a formidable balance: one foot in tradition and the other in the avant-garde. Barcelona has the reputation of being the most cosmopolitan, modern and avant-garde city in Spain and it was substantially renovated on the occasion of the 1992 Olympic Games. Since then, Barcelona has been transformed in world hub of cultural, telecommunication, musical and sailing events, to name a few. In 2004, the city organized the Universal Forum of Cultures. Since 2006 Barcelona hosts the Mobile World Conference, thus becoming the world capital of the mobile business for one week. In 2023, Barcelona hosts the Integrated Systems Europe (ISE), the largest world event on Audio/Video technologies.

Regarding musical concerts, Barcelona hosts multiple musical events. Since 1994 and 2001, it hosts the Sonar and Primavera Sound festivals, respectively, two of the largest musical events in Europe. Regarding sailing, Barcelona organizes annual competitions (e.g., Conde de Godó Trophy). In 2024, Barcelona will host the 37th edition of America's Cup, the most important world competition in sailing. These are just a few of the events in dynamic city. More examples can be found in the cultural events section ahead.





Travel

Getting to Barcelona by plane

The Barcelona airport has several terminals and is located 16 kilometers south of the city center. Its official name is Josep Tarradellas Barcelona-El Prat.



From the airport to the venue which is located in Castelldefels, you can come:

- **By taxi:** Follow the taxi signs at the airport. The cost of a ride to Castelldefels or CTTC is around 25 € and takes around 10 minutes in normal traffic conditions.
- **By train:** Take the train line R2N towards Sant Celoni and change at El Prat de Llobregat station to the R2S line towards Vilanova i la Geltrú or Sant Vicenç de Calders. Get off at Castelldefels (not Castelldefels Platia!). The travel time is about 20-25 minutes. Single ride tickets cost 2.80 €, multi-personal/multi-use tickets for 10 rides (T-10) cost 13.00 €. Both can be purchased at the ticket machines in the railway stations. From Castelldefels CTTC foot 10 minutes station. can be reached on in (https://goo.gl/maps/Z5QHkvR9FNqJT9yr6).
- **By bus:** Take the bus line L99. This is the most inexpensive option, but the bus ride is very long (about 40 minutes), therefore we do not recommend it. The bus stops at the Pg. del Pitort station, from where CTTC can be reached on foot in 6 minutes. Single-ride tickets for 2.50€ can be purchased directly from the bus driver (cash only). Other tickets such as multi-personal/multi-use tickets for 10 rides (T-10 for 13.00 €) can be purchased with cash or credit card from the ticket machines at the railway station of the train line R2 at the airport.
- **By Car:** There are 2 possible routes: (i) Follow highway C-32 and take exit 46 "Castelldefels"; or (ii) Follow highway C-31 and take exit "Canal Olímpic". It takes around 10 minutes in normal traffic conditions.



Transportation to Barcelona

From Castelldefels there is a direct train connection and a metropolitan bus line to Barcelona.

- **Train:** R-2 rail line from Castelldefels to Barcelona Sants station). It takes 20 minutes. 3-4 departures per hour.
- **Bus:** E95 bus line from Castelldefels-Santiago Rusiñol to Barcelona-Ronda Universiitat. It takes 50 minutes.
