TUESDAY, 23 MAY 2023, 9:00 AM

1. Welcome to participants

Prof. Laurent Clavier, Chair of the Action, opened the meeting on May 23rd, 2023, at 9.00 am. As Local Organizer, Prof. Carles Anton-Haro welcomed the participants and provided information about the local arrangements.

Prof. Laurent Clavier then acknowledged the fulfilment of the quorum, i.e. at least two-thirds of the COST countries participating in the Action were represented at the 5th MCM.

2. Adoption of agenda



The GHSR then showed the expected expenses to the MC Members and proposed a reallocation from the Meetings category to other Networking Activities, in particular, Training Schools and Dissemination and Communication Products items.

The abundance of budgets allowed to propose an increased number of students to be reimbursed as first expected in the next Training Schools.

For what concerned the Dissemination category, the reallocation would fund a promotional video of the action to be recorded during the meeting has been proposed.

The proposals were approved unanimously.

5. Training School Activities summary

Prof. Luis Correia, the Training Coordinator (TC), reported the selection process for the training school proposals. The TC invited the audience to apply to the call for proposals for the Training Day in Poznan and future Training Schools.

The TC reported the activities of the training day in the last meetings in Barcelona and Dubrovnik.

The TC notified the MC Members about the planned activities in 2023 for the Training Schools of DolCom and ESoA.

6. STSM & more

Prof Carles Anton-Haro, the Grant Award Coordinator (GAC), presented the status of the nine completed STSMs and invited the attendees to apply for new STSMs grants.

The GAC explained and repeated the criteria for the evaluation of the STSM Proposals and reported the nine grants already awarded.

The GAC explained the aim of ITC Conference Grants and the budget dedicated to them and the new conference dissemination conference grant: Visibility Booster Grants (VBG), with a specific focus on the WIRS activities. Carles listed the criteria, requirements, priorities, and the selection and awarding process.

Call for applications available according to the budget are 6 STSM, 3 ITC, and 5 VBG.



7. Dissemination

The Science Communication Coordinator, Prof Margot Deruyck, updated the Members on the status of the Dissemination and Communication activities. Specifically, Prof Deruyck presented the outcomes of the Newsletter, the status of the social media, the drafting process of the leaflet, and the production of the podcast of the Action.

She informed the MC Members and all the attendees about the production of INTERACT Podcast and the features in the first new episode published on different distribution platforms.

The SCC announced the Newsletter meeting would be held the same afternoon, 23rd May, at 5.30 pm.

The SCC informed the MC Members and all the attendees of the promo video mentioned in the reallocation of the budget.

Ultimately, the SCC asked for inputs for further dissemination activities undertaken since the start of the Action, joint publication and any useful contribution for the foreseen 40th Anniversary of COST Actions in Telecommunications.

8. Datasets

Mr. Marco Skocaj, Co-Chair of HA1, announced the upcoming INTERACT ML challenge, which is one of the core activities of Horizontal Activity. The upcoming challenge will be split into two sub-challenges, one focused on PHY layer, and the other on NET layer. Some initial information was communicated to the attendees. However, further details will be communicated via email since at the time being, everything is still to be decided.
